Bill Protecting Children Now Law



House Bill 355 is now on the books in Pennsylvania! The act, which will increase sentencing for those who prey on children from a position of authority, was unanimously passed in the House and Senate and signed into law by the governor in June as Act 5 of 2025.

The bill was inspired by constituents of mine, Chris and Grace, to whom I'll forever be grateful. Their advocacy for protecting minors was a key factor in the passage of this important initiative.

Protecting minor victims from exploitation and abuse should be a priority for any legislative body. Enhancing the penalties for those committing these egregious acts sends a very clear message that this form of predatory behavior is unacceptable and won't be tolerated.
